NORIAKI KASAI

Noriaki Kasai was born on 6 June 1972. He is a national Japanese ski jumper. He began jumping in 1990 and he is still taking part in competitions. Now Noriaki is the oldest ski jumper in the world. He only jumps in contests. Kasai ignores trainings. This Japanese ski jumper is triple Olympic medalist and he has won medal for Japan four times. He has stood on the platform 64 times. In this year on 4 January he took part in the 4 Hills Tournament for the hundredth time, so organizers of this competition gave him a memorial cake and a t-shirt with number 100. On 19 March 2017 he grabbed his life record 241,5m on the Vikersundbakken in Norway. In the general classification of ski jumping season (16/17) he took high 18th position. In private life Noriaki has a 12-year younger wife and one-year-old daughter. They lives in Sapporo. [MartaT]



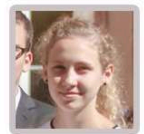
Bogdan Eugeniusz Junod - Eugeniusz Bodo

Bogdan was born at 1899 in Genewa, died in 1943 in Kotłas. Bodo was a famous singer, actor and director. He appeared in many movies: Piętro wyżej, Czerwony Błazen, Głos pustyni. He sang Sexappeal, Dzisiaj ta i jutro ta, Ach, te baby.

He was a famous actor and singer in Poland.

Eighteen-year-old Bogdan lived in Łódź. His father (Teodor) had a cinema and a theatre Urania. His mother (Dorota) had a restaurant in Łódź. When Bodo was eighteen years old, he escaped. He lived in Poznań. Eugene worked with Elna Gistedt, Nora Ney, Reri, but he never married. He had a dog (Arlekin) Sambo. He loved it the most.

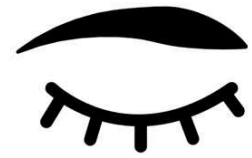

what is SNAPCHAT?



This application was developed by Evan Spiegel, Bobby Murphy and Reggie Brown and it appeared for the first time in July 2011. It's a mobile app which is designed for mobile devices only. The app is a tool for communication between close friends. Users send photos and videos which can be shown only 10 seconds, then they disappear. You can edit every photo or video (change filters or add text). Later an option My Story was added. It's a collection of photos and 10 minute video which briefly describe what you do on a specific day. However, your friends can watch them only 24 hours - after that they disappear and they won't be available to anyone. A characteristic symbol of this app is a white ghost on a yellow background. In the beginning the application was called „Picaboo”. Two months later, the name was changed to „Snapchat” which is until today. At present, 100 million people use it every day.[EmiliaL]

Six curiosities about Poland (ZuziaS)

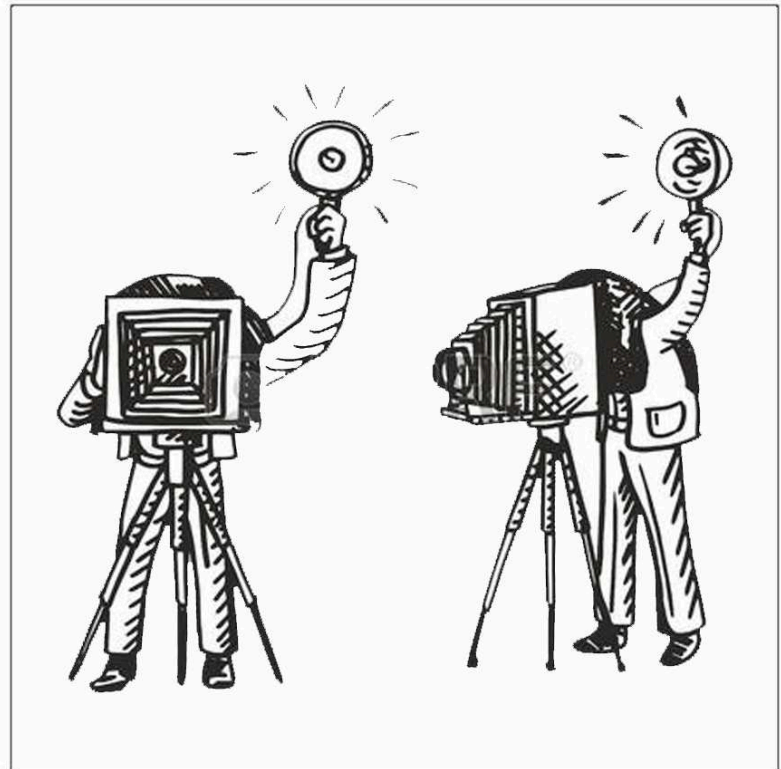
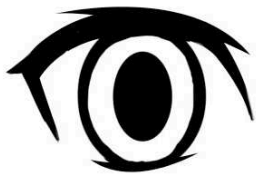


- 1. The center of Poland - In the village of Piątek, 33 km north of Łódź, is the geometric center of Poland. In the center of the village is a monument that symbolizes it.**
- 2. The dirtiest European country? According to the ranking, which was developed by the European Environment Agency, 6 out of 10 most polluted cities are in Poland. The "dirty" top ten are: Krakow, Nowy Sacz, Gliwice, Zabrze, Sosnowiec, Katowice.**
- 3. The youngest married couples? It turns out that the typical age at which Polish people marry is 24 years for women and 26 years for men. This is about seven years before, for example in Sweden.**
- 4. Polish Day national holiday in ... Argentina! Argentina is the only country in the world, where every year, June 8, celebrates The Polish Migrant Day. "Día del Colonio Polaco", ie Polish Settler's Day was established in 1995. It is a national holiday that commemorates the arrival of the first Poles to Argentina. This event dates back to the beginning of June 1897 year.**
- 5. Radom is larger than Paris Radom is located in Mazowsze. It turns out that a small Polish town is larger than the French capital, despite the fact that in his area are 10 times less people. Radom area is 11.8 square kilometers, while the Paris 105.4 square kilometers.**
- 6. Warsaw - a city that has seen war. Warszawa in English is „Warsaw”, which is literally "saw war." This term is so accurate, that after the fall of the Warsaw Uprising and subsequent hostilities, 85 percent of buildings of the capital lay in ruins.**

PHOTOGRAPHY



Photography is one of the ways of keeping important events which happened in our lives. Nowadays it's something very common, but when it was invented in 1800 it wasn't as common as today. It was Thomad Wedgwood who made the first known attempt to capture the image. He ended up with darker objects on the surface in a direct sunlight which darkened all over. The first person who captured a permanent photography was a French inventor Niepore Niepce.



But his camera had some issues, for example it needed a very long time of expousure, probably even several days.

So there obviously was another inventor who tried to improve the quality of those photos. This time it was Luis Daguerre (he worked with Niepce). They wanted to create something new, more practical and faster.

In 1835 the change appeared, the photos became more realistic and a little bit more similar to those today.

As you can see nowadays photographs have improved a lot, and it still will probably have a better quality. (JulkaK)

The Czech national team played games at this stadium in Euro 2012 tournament.

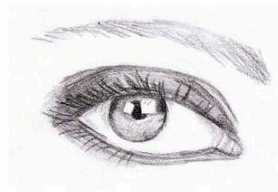
At the moment the coach of Śląsk is Jan Urban, and the captain is Piotr Celeban.

The 1000th goal for Śląsk was scored by Krzysztof Wołczek in the match with Cracovia

Finches are common birds in Europe. The most famous species is chaffinch which has the biggest population of the all birds in Poland (the second one is skylark population). The three other most common finches, goldfinch, greenfinch and linnet, have big populations too. The rarest finch in Poland is redpoll. Finches can be found mostly in Europe and west Asia. They live nearly everywhere: in the fields, in the woods, mountains and in the gardens. Finches have specialized beaks which are able to eat any kind of seed. They are colorful like a goldfinch or greenfinch. They are easy to recognize, so watch birds around you carefully. [MikołajL]

YouTube is a web service, which was founded in February 2005. This service allows to publish, play, rate, and comment videos. In 2010, 85,000 new videos appeared on YouTube every day. YouTube was founded by Chad Hurley, Steve Chen and Jawed Karim. The creators provided the first version of the service in May 2005, six months before the official debut of YouTube. The first film that was posted on YouTube was "Me at the zoo" by user "Jawed." The film was uploaded on April 23, 2005 at 20:27. The most popular video on YouTube is a video for the song "Gangnam Style" - PSY. A wide range of topics on YouTube videos has meant that Internet video has become one of the most important parts of Internet culture. The platform is available in 42 countries and 54 languages worldwide. Interface in Polish has been added June 19, 2007. According to a study of 16 July 2006 on YouTube has been viewed 100 million videos daily, and 65 thousand published.
